

YO CANADA!: THE RULES:

1. Players take turns rolling the die and advancing their markers on the board.
2. You may move in any direction but must NOT retrace your path on the same move.
3. If you choose to land on a special square, pick a corresponding card:

Green Squares

The green cards all contain questions on facts about Canada.

- Pick a card.
- Read the question aloud to the other players. (Do not give the answer.)
- The first person to answer the question correctly takes a token.
- If the first answer given by one of the players is the correct answer, you also take a token.

Flag Squares (Red Cards)

The red cards all contain discussion subjects about Canada.

- Pick a red card.
- Read the subject listed on the card and give your opinion.
- All the other players can then react to your comment.
- Everyone who participates actively in the discussion (minimum 2 sentences) takes a token.
- You take 2 tokens if you make at least 3 comments.

Blue Squares

The blue cards are “take a chance” cards.

- Pick a blue card.
- Follow the instructions on the card.

Picture Squares

The picture square is a **free** square.

However, if you choose to say something about the picture, you earn a token.
Careful! The same fact or ideas **CANNOT** be repeated!

4. Players may NOT occupy the same space.
5. Players must collect a **minimum of 15 tokens** before they can head for “YO!”
6. The game is over when the first person reaches “Yo!”
7. A player must have the **exact number** to land on “Yo!” and end the game.
8. Careful! The winner of the game is the player with the **MOST** tokens.
